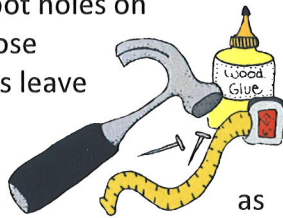


To the new members a big welcome and its hoped that your stay with the club is enjoyable.
